Visitation Information

Visitation is held on Wednesday or Sunday from 9:00 am or 9:30am and 1:00pm (20min.visits), depending on the housing assignment. Housing assignment and visitation times will be given to the Inmate when they arrive at the Anderson County Jail. All visitors 16 years of age and older must have a valid picture ID. Person 15 years of age and younger are not required to have an ID.

Driving Directions

Driving directions to 1200 E Lacy St, Palestine, TX 75801

112 mi – about **2 hours 12 mins**

1. Begin at the Brazos County Detention Facility – 1835 Sandy Point Rd., Bryan, TX 77807
2. Turn Right onto FM 1687/Sandy Point Road - .5 miles
3. Turn Left at San Jacinto Lane/TX Hwy 21 – 38.7 miles
4. Turn Left and merge onto I-45 N. – 36.1 miles (at Madisonville)
5. Take exit 178 for US-79 toward Buffalo - .4 miles
6. Turn Right at US-79 – 33.4 miles (at Buffalo)
7. Continue on W Dak St/W Oak St/US-84 – 1 mile
8. Turn Right at W. Spring St./Tx19/US-287/US-84 - .6 miles
9. Slight left at Ave. A St./State Spur 127 - .3 miles
10. Slight right at E. Crawford St./TX-127 – 361 feet
11. Turn Left at N. Perry St./TX-127 – 354 feet
12. Turn right at E. Lace St. - .06 miles
13. Arrive at the destination on the left – 1200 E. Lacy St. Palestine, TX 75801
