VISITATION INFORMATION

- I. Inmate Visitation List** - All visitation lists must be filled out with the visitor's name as it appears on their identification card or drivers' license and must include the correct street address. This will be the Authorized Visitor List.
- A. If the address is unknown, the inmate can take the visitation sheet to the tank with them. The inmate can call someone to verify the addresses and then record it on the visitation sheet. Inmates must turn in the visitation sheet before the end of the first shift they were classified (when the telephones are on).
- B. All authorized visitors, including minor children, must present a current and valid state issued driver's license or ID card.

MAIL & COMMISSARY INFORMATION

- I. Inmate Trust Fund** - The Brazos County Office of the Sheriff stopped accepting cash deposits to the Inmate Trust Fund (Commissary). All deposits must be in the form of a US Postal Money Order payable to the receiving inmate.

NOTE

If the US Postal Money Order or reading mail goes to the wrong address, it will be placed in the inmate's property in booking.

If the inmate's name is not legible or if the inmate has been released from the custody of the Brazos County Jail on the date received, the US Postal Money Order will be returned to the sender.

COURT INFORMATION

- I. **BACK CREDIT** - The BRAZOS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE does not handle back credit records for inmates sentenced to TDC, SAFPF, or State Jail. All inquiries for back credit for these types of sentences should be sent to the BRAZOS COUNTY DISTRICT CLERK.
- II. **COURT DATES** - The BRAZOS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE does not set court dates. Any requests for information concerning court dates should be forwarded to the court assigned for your case.
- III. **BONDS** - The BRAZOS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE does not set or reduce bond amounts. ONLY the presiding court can set bonds. Any request for bond settings or bond information should be forwarded to the court assigned for your case.
 - A. Unfortunately, the Sheriff's Office Court Coordinator Staff is unable to return responses for these types of information.
 - B. Other requests for information received by our office will be reviewed. When possible and appropriate, responses will

be sent at the earliest opportunity of the Court Coordinator Staff.

- I. **Consulate Offices** - Any Inmate who is a foreign national may contact the Consulate Office for their country. A request for contact information should be addressed to the Support Supervisor.
